Disclosure of the insurer's use of or ability to use non-OEM crash parts must be made to consumer in the insurance policy or **Disclosure - Insurance Policy:** time of policy purchase.

Disclosure of the intended use of non-OEM crash parts made as part of the repair estimate; unless otherwise noted, this also

includes a statement in or attached to the estimate, along with listing the non-OEM parts to be used.

The consumer must give his/her consent, either written or verbal, for the use of non-OEM crash parts prior to their use in the repair; or gives consumers right to choose which parts are used without specifically calling for consent for non-OEM, as noted.

The consumer must give his/her consent, either written or verbal, for the use of non-OEM crash parts, but with certain limitations. Usually refers to the length of time the requirement applies---see notes.

Estimate Sign-off: Consumer is required to sign repair estimate before the repair can proceed.

> Non-OEM parts must be "like kind and quality" to OEM parts, or the parts on the vehicle prior to the accident. Usually means they're required to at least equal OEM parts in terms such as quality, fit and performance---see notes for variations.

Airbag Law: The state has some kind of law or regulation pertaining to the repair or replacement of airbags---see notes for specifics.
